CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

GENERAL NOTE:

You have achieved the honour of being selected in a representative team of this Association. As a representative you will be acting as an Ambassador for not only this Association but also for hockey in general.

You must respect the rights, dignity and worth of others regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

As a responsible team member, you are required to abide by this Code of Behaviour as outlined.

Remember, your behaviour will determine the opinions that people will hold of the Sydney Junior Hockey Association. Our Association has a proud record - please strive to uphold it.

AS A TEAM MEMBER

- 1) At all times co-operate with your coach, team manager, team mates and opponents. Without them you do not have a competition.
- 2) Work equally hard for yourself and your team, your team's performance will benefit and so will your own.
- 3) Be a good sport. Encourage fellow team members by being positive at all times.
- 4) Control your temper. Make no criticism, either by word or gesture or body language. Realise that bullying, physical and verbal abuse is unacceptable behaviour.
- 5) Respect officials' decisions at all times.

AS A GUEST IN A MOTEL

- 1) Observe common courtesies by saying "Thank You" and "Please".
- 2) Do not leave the motel without first gaining the permission of your team manager.
- 3) Treat the motel rooms and facilities with respect. **PARENTS PLEASE TAKE NOTE: Any damages and costs resulting from carelessness and misbehaviour WILL BE PAID FOR BY THOSE INVOLVED.**
- 4) Rooms should be maintained in a neat and tidy condition at all times.

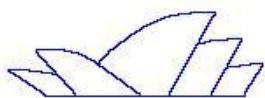
Parent(s) or Guardian(s) Consent

PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

As a parent/guardian of a player in a Sydney Junior Hockey Association representative team, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity related to the team's training or games:

1. Respect the rights, dignity of yourself and others.
2. Remember that your child participates in sport for their own enjoyment, not yours.
3. Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
4. Never ridicule or yell at your child or another child for making a mistake or losing a game.
5. Show appreciation for good performance and skilful plays by all players – including opposing players.
6. Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would be no game.
7. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility, recognising that at all times your words and actions are an example to others.
8. Be aware that you not only represent SJHA but also your club and family.
9. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
10. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport (player, coach, umpire and so on).
11. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
12. Be a positive role model. Positive comments are motivational.
13. Realise that bullying, physical and verbal abuse, neglect or any other type of abuse is absolutely unacceptable conduct in the sport of hockey.
14. Consumption of alcohol should be in moderation when in charge of minors. Please remember that some clubs and/or associations may have a "No Alcohol" policy within their grounds which you must abide by.

We look forward to an enjoyable hockey season with you and your family.

Any breach of the above Code will be dealt with in the following way:

- A warning will be given by manager, coach or a member of the SJHA Committee
- Another breach of the Code will result in your child sitting in the dugout for the remainder of the game or training.
- Any further breach of the Code will result in you being requested to leave the hockey game/tournament/training with your child. Further action may be taken depending on the circumstances of the infringement.

SJHA gives the coaches and managers of all of our SJHA teams the authority to take the actions as stated above should it be necessary.



CODE OF BEHAVIOUR – STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

This Code is to be discussed by coaches and managers with their teams. It is to be signed by each player and a parent or guardian and handed to the Hockey NSW Tournament Office by team managers before the commencement of the relevant Age Group State Championship.

As a team member, I will:

- Compete by the competition rules and conditions.
- Not argue with umpires', judges' or referees' decisions.
- Work equally hard for my team and myself.
- Be a good sport, encouraging and supporting my team-mates.
- Respect opponents and their skills and be friendly towards all participants.
- Co-operate with my coach, manager and team-mates.
- Not keep hours, which will detract from my own, and team, performance.
- Not take part in social activities not organised or approved by my team manager.
- Be responsible, aware I am representing my family, my club, my hometown or city.

I acknowledge that smoking, drinking of alcohol and taking non-prescribed drugs is strictly forbidden.

I am also aware that serious breaches of this Code of Behaviour will result in being prohibited from further participation in the Championship and that my parents or guardians will be notified. Costs caused, for example, by damage to other people's property, will be the responsibility of my parents or guardians.
